



Waterberg Wilderness

Waterberg Wilderness lies on the south-eastern flank of Waterberg on the D 2512 / D 2612 gravel road, 8 km northeast of Waterberg Plateau Park Resort.

If you can manage to arrive before 15h00 you will easily be able to join our afternoon activities.

The route through the scenic tree and shrub savannah of the east usually poses no problem for ordinary cars. But during the rainy season from December to April it may become unfit for traffic. You then take the tar road B 1 (Windhoek to Otjiwarongo) and the C 22 to Okakarara. There you turn onto the D 3827 and drive another 28 km to the reception of Waterberg Wilderness.

Hoba Meteorite – Probably hit earth 80,000 years ago. Contains mostly iron, weighs 50 to 60 tons, thickness 1 m, length of the side about 3 m, among the largest meteorites in the world (20 km west of Grootfontein, open all day).

Okahandja – Two street markets selling wood carvings and souvenirs from Namibia and other parts of southern Africa (all day).
